Bright Blessings first began in 2005 as a monthly birthday program for children staying at the Salvation Army Center of Hope in Charlotte, North Carolina. Our organization's founders, John and Amy Cervantes, wanted to help brighten the lives of homeless or impoverished children while also instilling a love and commitment for community service in their own young children. What started as a family project to celebrate homeless and impoverished children on their birthday has grown in ways we could not have imagined.

Today, Bright Blessings remains a volunteer-led organization that impacted more than 28,000 homeless and impoverished children in 2023. Through our core programs; Bless-A-Birthday, Bless-A-Baby, Gift of Literacy and Gift of Care, we are able to reach thousands of children every single month. Bright Blessings now has partnerships with over 30 local agencies and is serving school children in the following 4 counties: Mecklenburg, Union, Cabarrus & Gaston.
